


Elite Centre for Manufacturing Skills

The Elite Centre for Manufacturing Skills (ECMS) is a new employer-led training facility based in the Black Country, designed to enhance productivity in the region's high value manufacturing sector. The training centres, based in Wolverhampton and Dudley, provide facilities designed to drive economic growth in the region through the upskilling of current and future workforces – helping to close the skills gap in the manufacturing sector.

The centres are ideally suited for regional or national training organisations or manufacturing companies to host either one-off or regular staff development programmes. In addition, the ECMS Hub can provide a large event space for product launches, exhibitions or sales conferences. Both centres are ideally located with excellent transport links to the Midlands' motorway networks.

All facilities are available for full or half-day hire and some of the meeting rooms can be hired by the hour. Our booking team can provide dedicated event support for larger events and discounts are available for multiple/series bookings.



ECMS Hub, Springfield

The ECMS Hub is located on the recently renovated site of the old Springfield Brewery in Wolverhampton.

The brewery, which was constructed in the early 1880s, was in a poor state of repair; however, this has now been given a new lease of life by the University of Wolverhampton. The ECMS Hub is located in the old stable block, which has been fully refurbished with modern facilities and forms part of the University's architecture and the built environment super-campus. The Hub offers an employer-led training facility to enhance productivity within the region's manufacturing sector.

ECMS offers exhibition space and a range of fully equipped meeting rooms. There is also a fully equipped IT suite with CAD software on all 15 PCs.

All rooms have access to free Wi-Fi. We are open weekdays and evenings and can provide a catering service for refreshments and buffets.


